SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

The scholarship is available on two levels.

The first pays the tuition for a high school student to attend the Columbia College Television Department High School Summer Institute. Two will be awarded this year.

The second is in the form of a monetary scholarship (\$1,000.00) awarded to a graduating high school senior to be applied toward tuition at the college of his/her choice. In each case, the scholarship provides an opportunity to explore career interests and encourages students to continue their education in Television Production. Three of these scholarships will be awarded this year.

Applications due Monday, April 12, 2010

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Students who meet the following criteria are invited to apply:

- A graduating high school senior -OR- a high school junior or sophomore
- Currently enrolled as a full-time student
- Pursuing a career in media.
- Currently involved in a television production program led by a member of the Chicagoland Television Educators' Council.

Applicants must submit the following materials:

- A completed Nadine Sterk Scholarship Application w/attached narrative requests.
- A signed teacher recommendation form.
- A brief 5-minute video compellation portfolio of the applicant's best work submitted on DVD.
