What are you doing in your classes that you would like to share with your colleagues? Bring multiple copies of one of your lesson plans or a project,

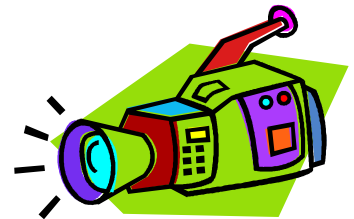
bring a piece of equipment (or pictures), etc...be ready to share!
